#### COPING SKILLS FOR RETIREES DURING A RECESSION

Stephen D'Arcy, Professor Emeritus of Finance University of Illinois

At risk of overstating the obvious, "these are difficult times." Giving us some perspective, Professor D'Arcy will share his insight into various financial instruments and vehicles to help us "weather the storm."

Professor D'Arcy has a broad background in the area of risk management and insurance. He recently retired as a Professor of Finance and the John C. Brogan Faculty Scholar in Risk Management and Insurance. He has served as the President of the American Risk and Insurance Association and of the Casualty Actuarial Society. He was a speaker on financial topics at the Big Ten Retirees Association conference that UIUC-SUAA hosted last August. His talk was so relevant and interesting that he was peppered with audience questions during and after his presentation. Thus, we felt it was important that our members also have a chance to hear from him and to ask him questions.

Among the topics Professor D'Arcy plans to cover are (1) investing during a recession; (2) preparing for the post-stimulus inflation; (3) making wise insurance decisions; and (4) estate planning. He will also provide handouts which will include recommended readings on these topics.

Join us for Steve D'Arcy's presentation and the discussion afterwards. It will be an afternoon well spent!

#### SUAA PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

So far 2008-2009 has been an active year for our SUAA Chapter, and it promises to continue to be so. Many of our activities are the topics of other reports in this Newsletter so I will only summarize them here. As I noted in my message last fall, the year began on a high note as we successfully hosted the Big Ten Retirement Association's 17<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference. As a follow-up, we have asked Stephen D'Arcy, whose presentation elicited the strongest interest from that group, to share his expertise with our members. The title of his talk and the topics he plans to cover are described in the Spring Meeting announcement on the first page of this Newsletter.

We hope that you can attend this meeting and perhaps bring along an additional member or an individual who is not yet a member! It will also give you another chance to see the new i-Hotel and Convention Center. We also hope that you will let us know if you are interested in becoming more involved in the Chapter's activities. Another important event being hosted by our Chapter this spring is the first set of Survivor's Benefit Workshops. These are the result of the work for the past two years of our Benefits Committee under the leadership of Judy Rathgeber, Walter Tousey, and Dennis Vidoni. I have attended the planning meetings of our Committee with SURS staff and have become aware of how important the topics covered are to our members. Information on the meetings and how to reserve a place are in the announcement in this Newsletter. In a related effort, the Committee has completed and published the Chapter's brochure on "A Guide to Survivors' Assistance" which is now available to our members.

The activities of the Communications Committee members Mary Beastall, Gary Engelgau, and Heidi Rockwood will have a significant effect on our ability to communicate with members of the Chapter in two areas: the Web Site and the Newsletter. Gary is our new web master and has supervised the transfer of our site to a new host. He has a number of plans for enabling us to communicate more effectively with our members who use the web and email for such contacts. Regarding the Newsletter, as was reported last fall, we faced the daunting task of replacing our long-time editor, John Chato. We are pleased that Heidi Rockwood agreed to be his successor. She brings a wide experience to the position, and this Newsletter is the first produced under her leadership.

We are aware of the importance to our members of the activities of our Legislative Committee. For example, among the more than 1,200 respondents to our questionnaire, an overwhelming proportion (over 90%) indicated that monitoring legislative actions and lobbying on behalf of annuitants were valuable services for the Chapter to provide. Thus, as Paul Dollins and Helen Satterthwaite indicate in their report in this Newsletter, a major goal for SUAA in general and our

Chapter in particular is to "to improve and increase our advocacy for past, present and future employees of the Illinois higher education community." This advocacy included the second mailing that we have ever sent to our members concerning an issue of concern to us. #### **SOCIAL SECURITY AND MEDICARE**

As you know, SUAA has continued to monitor and support potential modifications to Social Security law regarding the Government Pension Offset (GPO) and the Windfall Elimination Provision (WEP). These provisions have impacted many annuitants, and the UIUC Chapter requested personal statements regarding annuitant experiences. Several statements were received. The most common thread was the lack of information about GPO and WEP before retirement. The Chapter is reviewing current institutional communications intended for future retirees and will be making recommendations as appropriate.

Several annuitants had comments or questions about Medicare Part B, including eligibility and the cost of the monthly premiums. Each year

Medicare enrollees receive a booklet; in addition, information is currently available on the federal website <a href="http://www.medicare.gov">http://www.medicare.gov</a> (with links to "Medicare and You 2009" and then "Medicare Premiums and Coinsurance Rates for 2009"). Recently the monthly Part B premium has increased each year in January. This monthly premium cost may be impacted by an enrollee's modified adjusted gross income as reported on a prior year's tax return. There is no relationship between the Part B monthly premium cost and the GPO or WEP.

#### NOMINATIONS TO THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

At the spring meeting, four members are elected for three-year terms to the twelve-member Executive Committee. The four nominees selected according to Article V of our Bylaws are listed below. Additional nominees who consent to serve will be requested from the floor.

Steve D'Arcy retired in 2008 after 30 years at UIUC, first as a graduate student and then as a faculty member in the Department of Finance. His area of specialty was risk management and insurance. The courses he taught included, Introduction to Insurance, Employee Benefits and Financial Risk Management. He published papers on such topics as public pension funding, financial modeling and insurance regulation. He has served as Faculty Representative to the Employees Advisory Committee to the Board of Trustees of the State Universities Retirement System, on the Faculty Senate Council, the Senate Committee on the Budget and as Chair of the Faculty Benefits Committee. He also served on Governor Thompson's Task Force on Medical Malpractice in Illinois. For his professional organizations, he served as president of the American Risk and Insurance Association and of the Casualty Actuarial Society. Since his retirement, he founded D'Arcy Risk Consulting, Inc., a firm specializing in education, measurement and management of risk for organizations and individuals.

Paul Dollins retired from the University of Illinois in 1995 after serving as a Police Officer, Chief of Police and Director of Public Safety for a total of 26 years. He previously worked as a State of Illinois Drug Enforcement Officer for 8 years, a middle school teacher for 2 years, and served in the Military for 2 years. After retiring from the U of I, Dollins worked in Springfield as the Legislative Director of The Illinois Association of Chiefs of Police, leaving that position when he was appointed Chief of Police in Rantoul, Illinois in 2000. Dollins retired as Rantoul's Chief of Police in 2005. Dollins is an annuitant in the State Teachers Retirement System, the State Employees Retirement System as well as the State Universities Retirement System. He has been a member of SUAA for several years. He has served on the SUAA UIUC Chapter Executive Committee for three years and was elected to the SUAA State Executive Committee in 2008 for a three-year term.

Heidi Rockwood is an Administrative Assistant I

to the Vice President for Technology and Economic Development. She joined the office at its inception in 2000. Prior to that she served as Administrative Secretary to the Associate Dean of Administrative Affairs in the College of Engineering (1998-2000). Heidi began her career in the College of Engineering in 1984 as a Clerk Typist II in the Office of the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs. From 1986-1998 she served as the secretary for the Minority Engineering Program and from 1995-1998 as the COE Graduate Coordinator.

Robert Todd retired from the University of Illinois in 2003 after 27 years. During his career at the University he served as Director of the Illini Union, Associate Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs, and concluded his career as Associate Vice President for Administration and Human Resources. After retirement Bob worked as an independent consultant for the University serving as the owners' representative for the recently completed Alumni Center and the I Hotel and Conference Center. Prior to joining the University, he worked at the University of South Carolina and Northern Illinois University. He has served on the Krannert Center and Allerton Park Advisory Boards and presently serves as a member of the South Dakota State University Foundation Board of Directors.

## **LEGISLATIVE UPDATE**

SUAA State President Richard Johnson, a UI Chicago annuitant, has formulated four primary goals for our state-wide organization. The first three are to (a) grow our membership; (b) improve Chapter development of the fifty three SUAA Chapters; and (c) improve communications among Chapters through regional conferences and workshops. Finally, of most relevance for this report, we will move to improve and increase our advocacy for past, present and future employees of the Illinois higher education community. These are all laudable goals and our Chapter leadership strongly supports those goals.

We believe legislative advocacy is critical in protecting the welfare of higher education employees and retirees. The UI Chapter and many statewide Chapters have become much

more politically active in the last two years. Our Chapter's members met with our State Representatives and Senator in early 2008, and we attended receptions and golf outings for Representatives Naomi Jakobsson, Bill Black, and Chapin Rose and Senators Mike Frerichs and Dale Righter. We continue to make sure that they are aware of the interests and concerns of the 2000 plus Chapter members. Many statewide Chapters are similarly active and involved in legislative issues.

Last fall, our Chapter leadership felt strongly that we should support the State SUAA position opposing the ballot item in the general election proposing that the State should convene a constitutional convention. We prepared a special communication to all our Chapter members explaining this position. As you know, the proposal was soundly defeated.

Another concern we reported last year was the impact of the gridlock and dysfunction within Illinois State Government. A very positive development in January was the impeachment of Governor Rod Blagojevich by the House of Representatives and removal from office by the Illinois Senate. It is unfortunate that it took a crisis of this magnitude to bring about change and to put our public officials back on track to do the work of the people.

One legislative challenge this current session is a bill introduced on behalf of State Treasurer Alexi Giannoulias which would merge or consolidate the investment funds of SURS with those of the State Teachers Retirement System, the State Employees Retirement System, the General Assembly Retirement System and the Judges Retirement System. The principal reasons offered to support the proposal are that it will (a) strengthen the ethics laws for those administering the funds; (b) increase the transparency of the investment process; and (c) save on annual fees and administrative costs.

SUAA agrees with the positions taken by the SURS Board of Trustees in January. We support strong ethics standards and transparency and suggest that a separate bill be introduced to address these issues. We have substantial concerns, however, about the proposed merger and the Treasurer's cost analysis that is used to support it. For one thing, SURS investments

have a history of outperforming the other pension funds. Thus, the Executive Committee of the State SUAA voted unanimously at a committee meeting in Bloomington on January 26, 2009 to strongly oppose that bill in its current form.

This spring, we are part of the State SUAA's program to establish a system of Legislative Contact Persons (LCP). SUAA Chapters throughout the state will select individuals to work with local State Representatives and Senators on issues of importance to us. The process will begin when SUAA's lobbyist in Springfield, Dick Lockhart, informs us of a bill of interest to SUAA members. The LCP program can then allow us to contact our legislators fairly quickly to express our concerns.

We continue to monitor the status of the two social security offsets that have negatively affected many of our members: the Windfall Elimination Provision (WEP) and the Government Pension Offset (GPO). These offsets frequently hurt both those whose benefits have been reduced because they have also earned a public pension and survivors who find that the spouse's pension has been reduced after his or her death. Last fall, we sent letters of support to the United States House and Senate Sub-Committees considering resolutions to repeal these offsets. We have not heard of any results from these hearings and continue to support their efforts.

We thank all those members who contributed to **SUAAction** in 2008. SUAAction is the political action committee of SUAA and contributions enable us to hire a lobbyist to work for our interests and, further, the funding gives many of our members all over the state the opportunity to attend legislative fund raisers for local legislators whom we support. For example, it supported the contacts made by our Chapter members described above. We feel that the funding contributed so far has been well spent and encourage your continuing support for these actions.

#### ANNUAL SPRING MEMBERSHIP REPORT

The Membership Committee

A list of the 2,042 members who are current in their dues payments is included later in this newsletter. There are 1,368 annuitants on this list who are noted with an asterisk (\*) indicating they pay their \$30.00 annual dues by having \$2.50 deducted from their monthly State Universities Retirement System (SURS) annuity payment. The remaining 674 members have paid their dues in a single \$30.00 payment. Please check your name this list to be sure we have your membership correctly shown. If you paid dues during the past twelve months, and your name is not included on the list or improperly recorded, please inform us with a note to that effect or call our office phone at 217-333-5533.

We occasionally receive complaints from annuitants that a deduction was being taken from their monthly payment, but we were not listing them as members. In almost all cases members had approved a deduction for an organization other than the UIUC Chapter of SUAA. If you are a dues deduct member of our chapter, your SURS Statement of Benefits with your January payment should show the following deduction: U of I U-C Chapter SUAA - \$2.50. If it says something else, you should contact SURS to find out to whom you are contributing and why.

#### Why is your membership important?

SUAA works to protect our retirement benefits and the financial solvency of SURS. Even though the State Constitution says that retiree pensions shall not be diminished, changes have been made that affect new hires, and more may be proposed that affect current SURS participants. Other proposals surface regularly that could affect the financial health of the State's retirement systems, which have been repeatedly underfunded in past years. Had the State met its financial obligations when it was supposed to (and like all of you have done), the investment returns on these funds would have put the retirement systems in a much stronger financial position today. Also, adequate health care continues to be important to all of us. SUAA tracks all of these issues and makes our concerns known to the policy-makers. As SUAA becomes more involved with these matters, it gains visibility and respect and is now being consulted on matters affecting our benefits.

SUAA also monitors action being considered on the national scene. Current Social Security policies that reduce benefits for many of our annuitants continue to be reviewed in the Congress. Potentially increasing Medicare payments over the next few years loom for our members. As issues are identified and solutions proposed, a large SUAA membership will be important to maximize our ability to be heard, and gain favorable action. Your membership provides the opportunity to obtain the latest information on all of these issues and how to take action if needed. Membership also enables you to receive information about current activities on the UIUC Campus. A small single payment allows members to subscribe to *Inside* Illinois for life. Members also receive information about the activities of your UIUC SUAA Chapter.

# How to renew your membership or become a new member:

Current Dues Deduction members do not need to take any action, as their monthly deduction continues until they inform SURS otherwise. However, these members should report any change of address to SUAA as well as SURS. Annual pay members will be billed \$30.00 annual dues before the next anniversary of their renewal.

If you wish to join SUAA or your membership has lapsed, you should use the forms provided in this newsletter.

To become a dues deduct member, please complete and return Section A of the form. Because of its convenience we encourage you to join under this option, but it is currently available only to SURS annuitants.

If you prefer to join as a single annual payment member, please complete and return Section B of the form. Either way we welcome your membership!

#### **REPORT ON THE FALL 2008 MEETING**

The State Universities Annuitants Association, Urbana-Champaign Chapter, held its Fall Meeting on Sunday, October 26, 2008 in the new I Hotel and Convention Center on the campus near the Assembly Hall. Our program on SURS PENSION FUNDS, CURRENT AND FUTURE was delivered to a "standing room only" audience. We were fortunate to attract two noted and expert speakers to cover both the financial perspective, Dan Slack, Executive Director, State Universities Retirement System and the political perspective, Rick Winkle, Professor of Law and Fellow, Institute of Government and Public Affairs, University of Illinois. Each presented a review of government pension funding from their expert perspectives, financial and political. Then, both answered questions and heard audience comments.

Dan Slack, Executive Director of the State Universities Retirement System, is an old friend and the most frequent guest speaker, over the years, to our association's general meetings. He last updated us on SURS in the spring of 2005 when he was the SURS General Counsel and Associate Executive Director. He has since been promoted to Executive Director with oversight responsibilities for all SURS activities. Dan distributed handouts summarizing the SURS funding status and captured the essence with the statement, "Our portfolio is well diversified and structured in such a way to get through this financial crisis ... but there is no escaping the impact!" He recounted that SURS returns over the last 10 years have been 6.2%; over the last 20 years, 9.4%; and the last 30 years, 9.8%. He shared a chart with the rate of return for SURS for every year back to 1972. He was able to illustrate that after a year of negative returns, there followed several years of positive rate of returns and a rebound in the next years. Finally, he related that as severe as the financial crisis is, the prominent financial difficulty for SURS is the 20 % unfunded pension liability. Dan announced, at the conclusion of his remarks that he would be leaving SURS, in the New Year, to accept a comparable position in the state of Colorado. We wish him well.

Rick Winkle is also well known to our membership. Rick was both a State Representative and a State Senator from the Champaign-Urbana-Danville area and represented the University's needs to both the State House and Senate. Upon retirement from the Senate, he joined the University of Illinois staff as a Professor of Law and Fellow with the Institute of Government and Public Affairs. Rick recalled, for emphasis, that the 1970 Illinois Constitution has a Pension Protection clause specifying that employee pensions can not be diminished or impaired. While the State made a commitment to 90% fund the pension systems by 2045, other demands for funds, K-12 and health care as examples, have deferred the schedule, especially with a big bump in pension funding due for 2010. There is no requirement of the legislature to fully fund employee pensions, yet employee pensions are guaranteed. He observes that higher investment returns will not solve the underfunding problem which is, thus, unrelated to present financial difficulties. Some possibilities as remedy are selling pension obligation bonds, sale of state assets, or tapping employees for greater contribution.

Both commented upon the prospect, now voted down, of a constitutional convention. Rick related that the State Constitution has attempted to be amended 17 times and actually amended 10 times. Thus, amending the constitution may be more likely than a constitutional convention. Both commented that while pensions are solid, health insurance is not assured by the constitution.

We were extraordinarily fortunate to have speakers of this caliber on the same program. They are the best sources in their areas of expertise, financial and political, and those that attended were most pleased to hear their analysis and counsel. Thank you Dan and Rick!

# How to be listed in the Student/Staff Directory

The University no longer distributes and processes paper forms to identify those retirees interested in having their names included in the annual Student/Staff Directory. Retirees must now initiate the inclusion procedure by using the internet. To submit their name for inclusion in the 2009-2010 Directory, should visit:

Future retirees who will still be on the University's payroll on September 15, 2009 should not submit a form, as their listing will automatically be included in the Directory.

#### Subscribing to "Inside Illinois"

*Inside Illinois*, a newspaper prepared by the UIUC campus, is published twice a month except for December and January when it is published once due to the semester break. It is distributed free of charge to faculty, staff, and students on the UIUC campus. It can also be mailed to "interested UIUC annuitants" who are defined as members of SUAA willing to pay a \$7.00 charge to cover the expense of mailing the first year's subscription. After the first year, the subscription will continue at no charge to the subscriber as long their SUAA membership dues are kept current. This service is intended to meet the needs of annuitants interested in what is happening on the campus. Since SUAA volunteers are responsible for providing this home delivery, only dues paying members of the UIUC Chapter of SUAA may utilize this Service. It should be understood, however, that the Inside Illinois issues are mailed via bulk mail, so the newspaper is often received a week or more after being issued due to mail demands and where it is being delivered.

Dues Deduct and Single Cash Payment members now receiving a home subscription to *Inside Illinois* will continue to receive a complimentary subscription as long as they keep their SUAA dues current and keep the UIUC Chapter informed of their correct address. Those SUAA members who are not receiving a mailed subscription but would like to, should complete the Initial Subscription Form, below, and enclose a \$7.00 check payable to SUAA-UIUC and mail the form and check to the UIUC Chapter address on the form.

Address errors primarily occur with "dues deduct" members who assume that when a new address is updated at SURS, the state SUAA office receives the address change. This is not the case. Thus be sure to send any address change to the state SUAA office, using the form on the back of this newsletter. However, if you have a subscription to *Inside* Illinois, please send your address change form to the chapter address on this newsletter so that your *Inside Illinois* address will be updated. The chapter will then forward this address change to the state office.

The occasional statewide SUAA newsletter is emailed to those SUAA members whose email is on record at the state office, and hard copies of the newsletter are sent to members who do not have the email on record. Occasionally short informational pieces from the state office are sent to those members whose emails are on record, but may not be sent by hard copy to other members.
